

## Final Instruction Set Rubric (created and selected by the class)

Each separate instruction set will be graded individually on a 100-point scale. There is a total of 200 points for both sets of instructions.

<b>Category:</b>	Instruction Set # 1 (100pts.)	Instruction Set # 2 (100pts.)
<b>Creativity</b> (15pts.)—Is this a unique idea? Would people be attracted to doing these instructions?		
<b>Aesthetics</b> (20pts.)—Is it pleasing to the eye? Do the non-textual elements help the instructions or confuse the reader?		
<b>Grammar</b> (10pts.)—Is the grammar appropriate to the context and audience? Are there any mechanical issues that detract from the instruction set's ethos?		
<b>Format</b> (10pts.)—Does the medium fit the type of instructions? Does it use the features of the medium in a creative way?		
<b>Arrangement</b> (10pts.)—Do the non-textual elements connect with the textual information in the instruction set? Is everything organized and ordered appropriately?		
<b>Comprehension of instructions</b> (25pts.)—Do the instructions make sense? Are there any problems or omissions?		
<b>Target audience</b> (10pts.)—Do the instructions pertain specifically to the needs, values, and expectations of the audience? Is there a clear difference between the two audiences?
