<b>Annotated Bibliography</b>	<b>Point Range/Value (0-10)</b>
The Annotated Bibliography entries conform to MLA format standards.	
The annotations contain all requisite information, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Credibility of author and bias or perspective</li> <li>· Thorough summary of source</li> <li>· Intended audience</li> <li>· How the source may be useful in your work</li> </ul>	
<b>Explanatory Report</b>	<b>Point Range/Value (0-10)</b>
The report clearly states the problem at issue. This explanation is thorough and detailed.	
The organization is easy to follow and contributes to the overall purpose of the report. Moves between different sections of the report are clearly signaled to the reader.	
The research is incorporated effectively; that is, the paraphrases and quotations appear to be there for a reason, and the writer has woven those citations into the text smoothly. The sources contribute to the author's point rather than controlling the paper.	
The sources are appropriate and credible according to use, and The report utilizes an appropriate number of sources to present a thorough impression.	
The paper is of appropriate length to present a thorough impression.	
The report follows MLA format for in-text citations.	
The report follows MLA format for the "Works Cited" page.	
Overall, the profile is free of mechanical and grammatical errors.
