- 5. What do other people think, know, or assume about the subject being profiled? Do you share these views? What makes your perspective different?
- 6. What did you expect to find out about the subject being profiled? Were you surprised? What surprised you?
- 7. What dominant impression does the profile seem to create?
- 8. How do you think the author wants readers to see the subject of the profile?
- 9. How does the author establish such a perspective for readers?
- 10. Point to words (nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs), phrases, sentences, and passages that indicate the perspective the author offers to readers.
